## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Southport Board of Aldermen will hold a public hearing on Thursday, July 14, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Community Building, 223 E. Bay Street, to consider an amendment to the Southport Unified Development Ordinance (UDO):

ARTICLE 2: Basic Definitions and Interpretations  
Section 2-2: Definitions of Basic Terms

- (282) Residential Hotel. A building or group of buildings, **limited to a maximum of 10 rooms total**, providing lodging for persons, with or without meals, and intended and used for the accommodation of transient lodgers in suites designed in such a fashion that reflects the intended use for transient lodgers and not for permanent residential accommodation. Suites may have one or more rooms in addition to bathrooms, water closet compartments, laundry, pantry, foyer, communicating corridor, closets, or any dining alcove. Kitchen area separate from the living or sleeping areas shall be provided and cooking may be done only in the kitchen area. The definition of residential hotels shall not include housing units defined in this section, but may include services ordinarily provided by hotels, such as maid, desk, and laundry services.

Modification to this proposed amendment may be considered by the Board of Aldermen in response to comments received.

Interested citizens are encouraged to attend and comment on the proposed amendment.

This ordinance shall be effective upon the date of adoption.
