
**PROCLAMATION
STATE OF EMERGENCY REVISED
August 4, 2020**

WHEREAS, the City of Southport's Mayor Joseph P. Hatem adopted a State of Emergency Ordinance pursuant to the provisions of NCGS 14-288.12 to determine and proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to impose certain prohibitions and restrictions appropriate to meet the emergency needs of Hurricane Isaias. All City offices, not including essential personnel will be closing at 3:00 P.M. on Monday August 3, 2020 and will reopen when appropriate. All City Parks (including Waterfront Park), Docks, Piers and Riverwalks will be closing at 3:00 P.M. on August 3, 2020 until rescinded. Beginning at 3:00 P.M. today August 3, 2020, the areas on the Waterfront from Kingsley Park, Yacht Basin Drive, Brunswick Street to Southport Marina on Bay Street, will be closed to the Public due to high waters and potential flooding.

THEREFORE, there will be a mandatory curfew issued for the City of Southport beginning at 6:00 P.M. on Monday August 3, 2020 until 7:00 P.M., August 4, 2020, by Mayor Joseph P. Hatem due to extensive damage on the Waterfront and surrounding areas. Please do not get on the roads, it is too dangerous. If there is an emergency, please call 911.
