Terms: 2 year term
Membership Composition: 8 members (residents of the city)
Meetings: 1st Tuesday every month, 5:00 p.m.
Major Function: Review and recommend action on all public beautification projects including AIA Plan, Planting Plans, Adopt-a-block cleanup programs, Street Scape, Sea Scape, community appearance, cemeteries

Planning Board

Terms: Members selected as statutory terms expire
Membership Composition: 6 members within city limits, 3 members from ETJ
Meetings: Meets third Thursday of the month, 6:00 p.m.
Major Function: Develop and administer the Unified Development Ordinance, and CAMA Core Land Use Plan

Board of Adjustment

Terms: Members chosen as statutory terms expire
Membership Composition: 6 members within city limits, 3 members from ETJ
Meetings: Varies on an as needed basis
Major Function: Act as Quasi Judicial body to hear appeals of Building Inspector's decisions on interpretation of Zoning Ordinance

Southport Forestry Committee

Terms: 2 year term
Membership Composition: 7 members
Meetings: 4th Monday of each month, 5: 00 p.m.
Major Function: To review and recommend actions to preserve and enhance the community's trees. Recognizing that the historical personality of the town is in part defined by its trees, in particular the live oaks. The committee's actions will include protection of existing trees, tree replenishment, public education and other functions related to the community's forest environment.
