## 1. Committee Reports

- a. Native Plant Pollinator Garden (NPPG): Larry Ashley
  - The new butterfly sign has been installed.
  - Larry suggests that mulch be laid down.
  - Kate Singley asked the board for their opinion on where to put the Bee City sign.
  - The board likes the idea of the sign on the birdhouse pole in the back of the garden.
- b. Communication Report: Larry Ashley
  - Larry will send pictures to the State Pilot of the SBC workdays.
- c. Youth Outreach: Lynne
  - Lynne will send an email to the HS contacts regarding students volunteering on our work days.
  - The SBC committee suggests to drop this position.

#### a. Sign Standardization: Lynne

- Garrison Lawn and Museum tables were stained.

- Weeding on Garrison and Waterfront was done.

#### 3. New Business

#### a. Yacht Basin Sign: Lynne

- Ken used the original wood and similar shape of the sign.
- Larry straightened out the pole for the sign.
- The pole will be painted orange.

#### b. Yacht Basin Boat: Lynne

- The boat will need a good scaping and then a coat of marine paint.
- The rudder needs to be fixed.

## c. Additional Sign Painting: Lynne

- Whittlers Bench sign needs to be painted.
- Randy stated that the bench belongs to the city and he will find out if we can paint it.
- The raised concrete map next to the pier needs to be painted.

## d. Holiday Lights and Funding: Lynne

- SBC will buy 130 packages of pure white light bulbs for the sailboat piece: 2 packages of white bulbs per wreath for 65 wreaths.
- We bought the green and red lights for the wreath section.
- Lynne will discuss with Randy the cost which should be around \$3,000.
- Lynne asked Randy about the auction money from the Historical Markers and if that money could be used for the cost of the light bulbs.

#### e. Holiday Decoration Planning Dates: Lynne

- Randy stated that the Fire Dept will give us a bay to work on the wreaths during the 1<sup>st</sup> two weeks of November.
- The committee asked if we could have the date moved up to October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Randy will check with the Fired Dept.
- Randy will also check with the electrical company regarding placing the wreaths on the poles by November 20th.
- Lynne will go thru the bins and check the lights. She will need extra help.
- Randy stated that December 1<sup>st</sup> will be the lighting of the tree ceremony.
- SBC will serve hot chocolate for the festivities.

## f. Future Work: Lynne

- Painting of the Garrison Lawn posts.
- We need to do something with the "garden" in the Oliver's parking spot.
- Caviness Stage: proposal of the replacement of floor boards and handrails. We will do the work and the city will buy the material.

- Weeding at the JC building.
- 3 benches on Moore Street near the Old City Hall need staining.
- 2 benches near Dry Street need staining.
- 2 tables in Franklin Square Park need staining.
