# C. Old Business.

- a. Approval of 5/28/25 minutes

  Motion by Lynne, seconded by Larry. Motion carried. Ayes (3), Abstain: Andy, David
  - i. Northwood Lane Sign- Status update Larry checked with sign company and Dan said that signs should be arriving the week of June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- b. Operations
  - i.Cemetery Mowing As per John N. Smith board's request, Best will continue to weed whack around the gravestones until the end of this year's contract.
  - ii.Water Connections at Northwood Cemetery -Still waiting for final connections by the county
  - iii.Tree limb removal- Tom Stanley and his crew finished large limb removal. This week they will work on removing small branches going into roadway lanes
- c. Discussion of Modifications to the Cemetery Ordinance continued from May meeting
  - 5-11 Foundations more specific language is needed with reference to depths, heights, footings
  - 5-12 Northwood regulations
    - 4) Change to 4-foot height including the base (4Ft total height)
    - 9) Footstones should not be allowed
    - 10) Planting is prohibited. Permanent receptacles on the monuments only
    - 11) Define coping. Allow with city permission
    - 12) Add: No corner markers permitted
    - 13). Add: No flames or lit candles

Some additional points to consider:

- Go back to Section 5-1 and consider more clearly defined terms on lots, markers, monument (flat or raised), permanent (fixed) grave marker
- Lots in general should they be subdivided and procedure for that. Fee for lot sales.
- Funeral Homes maybe put in something about setup and need for professional look with clean tents, carpets, chairs
